STORAGE

Always store in a cool and dry place. Ensure lid is tightly sealed after use.

What is Chalk Paint[®] Wax

Use Chalk Paint[®] Wax to seal and protect furniture and walls painted with Chalk Paint[®]. This soft wax brings out depth of colour and gives a beautiful matt finish — or can be buffed to a high sheen. Chalk Paint[®] Wax comes in Clear, White, Dark and Black so you can choose the look to suit your project.

Get started

Apply a thin coat of Clear Chalk Paint[®] Wax onto your painted surface, using a lint-free cloth or Annie Sloan Wax Brush. Work in small areas at a time, 'pushing' the wax into the paint.

White Chalk Paint[®] Wax can be applied directly onto painted surfaces. Apply Dark or Black Chalk Paint[®] Wax over wet Clear Wax. Remove any excess with Clear Wax and a clean cloth.

Wax every part of your piece at least once. Two to three coats will create a wipeable finish for dining room tables and kitchen cabinets.

For a high-shine finish, allow 24 hours before buffing with a clean cloth. Treat your finished piece with extra care while the wax cures — this can take between 5 and 21 days.

Aftercare

To maintain your finish wash with mild soapy water and a soft damp cloth, re-wax if necessary. Not recommended for areas with a lot of water. Not suitable for outdoor use. Wash brushes in hot water and soap immediately after use. Results may vary depending on previous treatment of surface. Always test on a small area first.
